We proudly invite you and your company to participate in the 17th Nordic Mass Spectrometry Conference, to be held in Espoo, Finland, on Aug 26–28, 2019. The conference is organized by the Finnish Mass Spectrometry Society. The conference will be held at the Hanaholmen Culture Center (address: Hanasaarenranta 5, Espoo, Finland), which is located 6 km from the city center of Helsinki. We expect approx. 150 mass spectrometry enthusiasts from Finland and other Nordic countries to participate. The lectures will be held in the auditorium of Hanaholmen, and they will focus on mass spectrometry theory and applications. International and national experts are invited to give lectures on the three-day conference. The sessions are divided into morning and afternoon sessions. All lunch and coffee breaks are arranged at the conference venue. The language of the conference is English.

Congress hall Tetra of Hanaholmen, where we arrange the coffee breaks, poster sessions, and a cocktail reception, will be available for the commercial exhibition. You can reserve an exhibition table, a space for a roll-up, poster presentation, or a lecture. Other sponsoring forms, such as sponsoring of the cocktail reception or conference dinner, are also possible. The exhibition fees are as follows:

The exhibition table includes a free registration for one person for the duration of the three-day conference. Any accompanying persons will also pay the conference registration fee (400 € or 500 € after Jun 20, 2019), which includes participation in the scientific program, lunches, coffee breaks, cocktail reception and conference dinner in restaurant Walhalla in Suomenlinna fortress. An abstract of the oral presentation is required in advance, by May 31st, 2019. As only a limited number of talks can be accepted, the organizers reserve the right to accept or reject abstracts.

Please note that there is limited room for exhibition, and therefore the organizing committee may have to limit the number of exhibitors.
